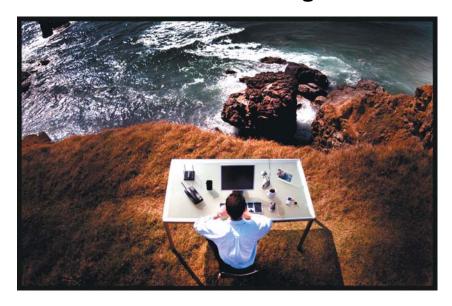
Team-Based Development The Jazz Platform and Rational® Team Concert Student Offering
